The Producer

LaGravera was born when the Arno family decided to carry out an unusual undertaking: to restore an old gravel pit to turn it into a unique vineyard. The winery is located in the district of Alfarras, in the Segria region. Under the requirements of organic and biodynamic agriculture, they work the 11.3 hectares of vines using advanced planting, monitoring and control techniques. Their tenacity and philosophy that respects the fruit and the environment has earned them the Special Mention for Innovation, Quality and Sustainable Development at the Rutas del Vino de Espana Awards in 2011.

Type of wine: White.
Alcohol Content: 13.0%
Grape Variety: White Garnacha, 20% Sauvignon Blanc
Origin: D.O. Costers de Segre
Vinification: Fermentation of the varieties separately in stainless steel with wild yeasts and aging with battonage of the lees.
Terroir of pebbles from the Noguera Ribagarcana river and sands with the presence of gypsum.

From la Serra Llarga to the glass: a versatile white.
Delicate and fresh floral profile with citrus notes, white and yellow fruit.
Refreshing saline and mineral finish.
Mixture of different landscapes of the Serra Llarga and an example of varietal biodiversity.
