GENERAL INFORMATION

This wine is produced from a careful selection of old, low-yielding vineyards located on the poor, stony terraces of the Ebro River in San Vicente de la Sonsierra, Rioja. Grapes are hand-harvested in October and vinified with minimal intervention, including spontaneous fermentation with native yeasts at 24°C and only very small additions of sulphur. A short static maceration of 8–10 days ensures balance and elegance without over-extraction. The wine is aged for 16 months in a combination of French and American oak barrels, allowing it to develop complexity while maintaining freshness.

TASTING NOTES

Displays a deep cherry-red colour with subtle tile-red hues. The nose is expressive, offering ripe red fruit and liquorice, layered with notes of coffee, vanilla, and balsamic nuances from oak ageing. On the palate, it is smooth and velvety, with sweet, ripe tannins that give an approachable, easy-drinking character. The finish is long, rounded, and persistent, leaving a harmonious impression of fruit and spice.
