GENERAL INFORMATION

This wine is made from 100% Mencia grapes grown in Valtuille de Abajo, within the DO Bierzo appellation. The vineyards are over 85 years old, producing very low yields of just 3,000 to 3,500 kg per hectare from clay and sandy soils that give the wine its distinctive character. Grapes are harvested manually in small 15 kg cases and carefully sorted on a selection table to ensure only the highest quality fruit is used. Fermentation takes place in stainless steel vats at controlled temperatures below 28°C to preserve freshness and varietal purity. The wine is unoaked, allowing the true expression of old-vine Mencia and its terroir to shine through. This is a precise and authentic reflection of Bierzo's viticultural heritage.

TASTING NOTES

The wine shows an intense red colour with vibrant violet hints. On the nose, it is exceptionally fresh, offering aromas of blackberries, wild berries, and a pronounced earthy character typical of Bierzo soils, alongside subtle roasted notes of smoke and liquorice. Delicate balsamic nuances, particularly mint, add further complexity. On the palate, the wine is firmly structured with remarkable depth, balanced by very fine tannins and a lively freshness. The finish is long, persistent, and driven by pure fruit, showcasing both elegance and intensity in perfect harmony.
