GENERAL INFORMATION

This red wine from Vinos Valtuille is crafted from 100% Mencia grapes grown in the Pago de Valdoneje estate within the Bierzo region of Spain.

Produced by Marcos García and his family, it reflects the maturity of old vines and the winery's distinctive style. With a limited production of 7,000 bottles and an alcohol content of 14.5%, this estate wine is considered a 'vino de pago,' highlighting both the unique terroir and the winery's individual character. Its slightly rustic and austere profile, with firm tannins, makes it a wine designed for contemplation, rewarding those who give it time to evolve in the bottle. It contains sulfites and is best enjoyed at around 18°C.

TASTING NOTES

The wine shows an intense cherry-red colour with violet highlights. On the nose, it is highly aromatic, revealing a complex bouquet of spicy notes, earthy undertones, and layered fruit aromas, including blackberries, floral hints of violets, and subtle roasted nuances. The palate is structured and profound, offering depth and a persistent, fruit-driven finish. While the tannins are firm and slightly rough, they contribute to the wine's complexity and aging potential, creating a balanced, elegant, and contemplative experience sip after sip.
